

Visit to Ngong Ping 360 (30 April 2011, Saturday)

Ngong Ping Cable Car is a 5.7km bi-cable ropeway. As the first of its kind in Hong Kong, the cable car journey begins from Tung Chung, crossing Tung Chung Bay to reach the angle station on Airport Island and turning in the air towards North Lantau.

From the last visit arranged for the Institute in 2007 by Ngong Ping 360 (NP360), Mr. Anderson Chow, Assistant Manager (Safety & Environment) of NP360 will once again to provide an update to the participants about the environmental achievements since the last visit.

Participation in this visit for member of HKIEIA is HK\$50 and for non-member is HK\$100 (including the fare for round trip of Crystal Cable Car). Lunch arrangement (optional) at Po Lin Monastery is available, at a fixed price HK\$60.

The total number of participants is limited to 30. Registration is accepted on a first-come-first-served basis and priority will be given to the members of HKIEIA. The itinerary is as follows:

All participants should arrange for their own transportation to the assembly point at MTRC Tung Chung Station. As the visit will involve considerable amount of walking on unpaved tracks, participants are reminded to wear suitable footwear.

Adverse weather arrangement: this visit will be cancelled if a typhoon signal No.3 or above, or any rainstorm warning is issued on 30 April 2011 (Saturday). HKIEIA will notify participants for the subsequent arrangement.
